WALK 5
Moderate Road/off-Road Walk
(9 Km) - Tragumna.

Walk through quiet roads and off-road tracks through the countryside and back to Tragumna for tea/coffee, returning by bus to Skibbereen Town.

Off-road gear essential, total ascent 250 m.
No dogs allowed.

Bus leaving Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **9.30 am Sunday** for transfer to Tragumna, returning later to Skibbereen by 2.30 pm.



WALK 6
Moderate Road/Off-Road Walk (12 km)
– Knocknamaddree, Goleen.

Walk through quiet country roads from Lissagriffin Lake to Carrigacat and Mileen and then off-road over Knocknamaddree and ending in Goleen for tea/coffee.

Off-road gear essential, total ascent 330 m.
No dogs allowed.

Bus leaving Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **10.00 am Sunday** for transfer to Goleen, returning later to Skibbereen by 5.00 pm.



WALK 7
Moderate Road/Off-Road Walk (11 km)
- Castledonovan/Mullaghmesha.

Visit Castledonovan Castle prior to walking on quiet country roads and off-road tracks over Mullaghmesha and back to Castledonovan with tea/coffee back at Skibbereen.

Off-road gear essential, total ascent 470 m.
No dogs allowed.

Bus leaving from Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **12.30 pm Sunday** for transfer to Castledonovan, returning later to Skibbereen by 6.00 pm.

WALK 1

Easy Road Walk (8.5 km) - Union Hall – Squince – Myross – Union Hall.

Walk through quiet country roads from Union Hall Church to Squince, passing Myross and Lough Cluhir on the way back to Union Hall.

Bus leaving Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **5.00 pm Friday** for transfer to Union Hall, returning later to Skibbereen by 8.30 pm.



Saturday 28th September 2019



WALK 2

Moderate Road/Off Road Walk (10 Km) – Knockaphuca, Toormore, Schull.

From Kealfadda Bridge over Knockaphuca, down to Dunkelly and ending in Goleen for tea/coffee.

Off-road gear essential, total ascent 470 m. No dogs allowed.

Bus leaving Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **9.00 am Saturday** for transfer to Toormore, returning later to Skibbereen by 4.00 pm.



WALK 3

Moderate Off-Road Walk (10 km) – Sherkin Island.

Walk through quiet lanes and off-road paths over Slievemore and back Horseshoe Harbour.

Off-road gear essential, total ascent 250 m. No dogs allowed.

Bus leaving Skibbereen Heritage Centre at **11.15 am Saturday** for transfer to Baltimore, ferry (**12.00 noon**) to Sherkin and return by ferry to Baltimore, returning later to Skibbereen by 7.00 pm.



WALK 4

Easy Road Walk (5km) – Lough Hyne – Knockanoulty – Barlogue – Lough Hyne

Join Terri Kearney from Skibbereen Heritage Centre for a walk through 4,000 years of Lough Hyne's history. This walk will cover the history, archaeology and folklore of this unique salt-water lake, taking in the Great Famine, Bronze Age artefacts and monuments, Holy Wells, coffin stones, castles, set dancing and a lot more besides

Meet at **2.00 pm Saturday** at the base of Knockomagh Hill, Lough Hyne.
